FUDGE RECIPE
SD Penitentiary Inmates
Christmas Sack Program

NOTE: **This recipe must be followed exactly.**
Please do not add or omit any ingredients. Each piece of fudge distributed must be identical. **Any variations will not be allowed inside the prison.**

1½ sticks butter or margarine

½ lb. Velveeta cheese

2 lbs. powdered sugar

½ cup unsweetened dry cocoa

1 tbsp. vanilla

½ cup chopped walnuts

½ cup semi-sweet chocolate chips

- In a large saucepan, melt cheese, chocolate chips, and butter together. Stir together until smooth. Remove from heat and add vanilla and nuts. (do not omit the nuts please)
- In a large bowl, stir together sugar and cocoa. Add melted cheese mixture. Mix well. The candy may be very stiff and mixing with gloved hands may be necessary.
- Press the candy evenly in a 9 x 13 inch pan coated lightly with nonstick spray.
- Cool and cut into 24 pieces. Wrap each piece in **plastic wrap**. Please do not put stickers, ribbons or any other adornment on the wrapped fudge as these are not allowed in the prison.
(No plastic bags – not allowed in the prison.)
